Spare Clothes

Sometimes our children will have toileting accidents at school or get a bit wet when they are playing in the water. We would appreciate it if the children could keep a bag on their peg with spare pants, trousers and socks so that if they are wet we can change them. You can leave this bag at school if you wish to.

Outdoor Play

We will go out to play in most weather and it is important that the children are appropriately dressed. In the wet weather please feel free to bring wellies to school and we will put them on when we go outside. The children will always need a waterproof coat in school and a hat and gloves in the cold weather.

3rd and 10th September Ourselves

During the first two weeks, we will be settling back into our routine after the holidays and beginning the new school year. We will be talking about ourselves and getting to know each other through lots of activities.

17th and 24th September Little Red Hen

In class we will be reading the story and using this to learn new skills and how to work as part of a team. We will also be using Little Red Hen's influence to bake some yummy bread! At home you could try to do some baking together, working together to reach a goal.



1st and 8th October Child Led Weeks

In these two weeks, we will be taking inspiration from the children and asking them what they would like to learn about. They will be able to tell you all about it nearer the time. You could talk to your child and send in ideas about what they would like to learn about – all ideas will be gratefully received.



15th and 22nd October Room on the Broom

In class we will be creating potions like the witch and conducting some experiments! We will be exploring 2D shapes and using them to help recreate the characters. At home you could look at what 2D shapes you can find around the house and in the environment. You could send us some pictures of your child spotting these shapes, so we can add them to their learning profile.

5th November Bonfire Night and Diwali

This week we will be talking about what makes Bonfire Night and Diwali special, and what similarities they have. We will also be exploring different music and instruments. At home you could talk about the importance of safety around fireworks and fires.




12th and 19th November We're Going on a Bear Hunt

During these two weeks we will be reading the story and exploring the different textures. At home you could watch the story on Channel 4's Website or go on your own bear hunt in the woods.



26th November and 3rd December The Gruffalo's Child

We will be reading the story and talking about the different animals we meet and their habitats. At home you could watch the story on CBeebies.



10th and 17th December The Nativity

Over the two weeks we will be learning about the story of Christmas and talking about how Christmas is a special celebration for Christians. At home you could talk about the different signs of Christmas you see such as the weather getting colder and the different decorations.
