Spare Clothes

Sometimes our children will have toileting accidents at school or get a bit wet when they are playing in the water. We would appreciate it if the children could keep a bag on their peg with spare pants, trousers and socks so that if they are wet we can change them. You can leave this bag at school if you wish to.

Outdoor Play

We will go out to play in most weather and it is important that the children are appropriately dressed. In the wet weather please feel free to bring wellies to school and we will put them on when we go outside. The children will always need a waterproof coat in school and a hat and gloves in the cold weather.

Snack Time

The children will be given a snack and drink at school every day. This is always a piece of fruit or a vegetable and water or milk. We ask that the children do not bring any other snacks or drinks to school so all children in Nursery have the same.

Muddy Mondays

Muddy Monday's will happen in all weathers (unless it is VERY windy or icy!), so please make sure your child has suitable clothes for the weather

They will need:

- Warm clothes including a jumper
- Strong shoes such as boots or wellies
- A waterproof coat.
- Hats/Scarves/Gloves in cold weather


28th January and 4th February The Three Billy Goats Gruff

25th February, 4th and 11th March


Goldilocks and the Three Bears
