Reading	<p><b>Predictions</b> Look at the picture what do you think the story will be about? Writing	<p><b>Spelling</b> Watch the video about silent letters and work through the activities. <a href="#">Online Resource</a></p>	<p><b>Adjectives</b> Draw a picture of the Big Bad Pig and collect some adjectives to describe him. Think about his personality as well as his appearance. Challenge yourself to turn these into expanded noun phrases. <a href="#">Expanded Noun Phrases</a></p>	<p><b>Wanted</b> Help to capture the Big Bad Pig. Using your adjectives from yesterday try to create a wanted poster with lots of detail. Look at the example to help. <a href="#">Lesson Resource</a></p>	<p><b>Creative Writing</b> Write your own chapter for the book. What would you make your house out of? How would the Big Bad Pig try to destroy it?</p>	<p><b>Adverbs</b> Recap adverbs using the link. Maths	<p><b>Timetables</b> Practice counting in 10s and your 10 timetable. How many can you get right in a minute? Can you beat your score? <a href="#">Timetables</a></p>	<p><b>2D Shapes</b> Watch the video to refresh your knowledge of 2D shapes. Think carefully about the materials you might choose for different parts of the house. Label your house to show which materials you have chosen and explain why.</p>	<p><b>Get Creative</b> Using materials at home can you build a nice strong house for the Three Little Wolves to live in?
